



2011 SCHOOL INTENT FORM

The Anti-Defamation League (ADL) developed the No Place For Hate® (NPFH) initiative to offer school members the opportunity to work together to combat prejudice and enhance a culture of respect. Schools that complete all NPFH requirements receive a No Place For Hate banner and will be given recognition within the education and ADL communities.

Follow these simple steps to become a **No Place for Hate** school:

1. Fill out this No Place For Hate School Intent Form
2. Create a No Place For Hate committee
3. Have all students and faculty sign the Resolution of Respect
4. Complete three or more anti-bias activities within the 2011-2012 school year, and submit one Activity Fulfillment form for each activity.

*Please note that participation in NPFH may be part of a school's plan to prevent and address bias-based harassment as outlined in **New York City Chancellor's Regulation A-832**.*



IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER:

- 9/7/11 – 12/1/11: Send in your School Intent Form
- 12/15/11: First Activity Fulfillment Form is due, along with supplemental material
- 2/29/12: Second Activity Fulfillment Form is due, along with supplemental material
- 4/20/12: Third Activity Fulfillment Form is due, along with supplemental material

All NPFH forms must be completed and returned by April 20th, 2012. Your school will be notified in late April 2012 if you have successfully completed all NPFH activities. The final conference and banner ceremony will be in late May.
