What will be DISCUSSED with students? What does respect look like, sound like, feel like.

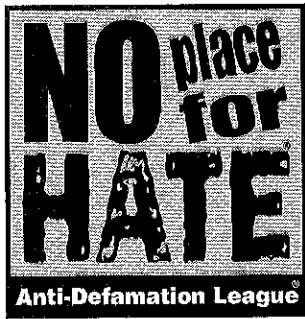
What ACTION will students take to demonstrate what they have learned? Each class will create a chart based on the discussion. The students will then create skits about ways to show respect and perform skits in class.

3) Describe the activity: WHO attended, WHAT happened, WHERE and WHEN it was, and HOW it impacted the audience. Also include how it met the three criteria: LEARN about the issues, DISCUSS the issues, ACT UPON the issues. Each student in every classroom created a "quilt"

square that told about their culture and heritage. Most students told about customs in their homes, cultural observances and holidays, traditional foods that are eaten, etc. Each student presented the information to his/her classroom and all presentations were discussed. Students learned a lot about each other. All quilt squares were then pieced together and displayed outside each classroom.
